To sell raffle tickets, please contact Steve Shires or Ron Morgan

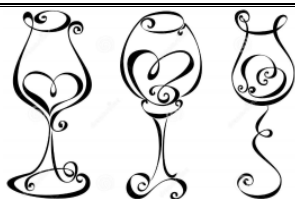
To work any of the games, please contact Jeff Dargiewicz
